## Club Notes (applicable to both pages)

The Southampton FA did not show clubs that had a team of a higher designation (e.g. one in the Senior Divisions or above) with the title of 'reserves' or 'third team' as the team competing in this competition was of the highest designation representing that club.

An example of this is **Southampton Telephone Area**. This club were the holders of the cup, having won it in 1945/46, but they had moved up to the Senior League that summer. The club's first team, having become of senior level, was therefore unable to defend the cup, but they entered their reserve team in this tournament. But as they were the only team representing the club in this particular competition they were not shown as a reserve team as such.

To show this an italical note has been inserted next to the club to show 'Res' for reserve team or 'third team' (self-explanatory).

Further confusion is caused by a single club entering two different teams in the same competition, as was the case of St Nicholas and Swaythling Athletic in this particular season. In such instances the first team were shown with the suffix 'A' and the seconds 'B'.

## **General Note**

Although this was a Southampton Football Association competition not all of the clubs were playing in the Southampton Football League. It was likely that some of the clubs entering were members of other local leagues, such as the Eastleigh & District League or New Forest League.
