## Best Progress by a Non-League Club in the FA Challenge Cup Since the Formation of the Football League

The features section of this website will regularly look at old publications and review them to see how what was written then has progressed (or perhaps regressed?).

The FA published a Yearbook with effect from 1948. The purpose of the publication was to give the public 'some idea of its activities and how football was organised.' The book reviewed the previous season, provided the fixture list for the season and also included other items of interest.

This feature comes from the FA Yearbook - Season 1951/52 - which reviewed the season just passed. The title of this piece in the Yearbook is as follows:

#### Why the age of the 'Giant-Killer' in Cup-Tie football has passed

"For the first time since the Football League was extablished in 1888-89, there was no club outside the League in the last sixty-four (of the FA Cup). This diagram indicates how far, year by year since the League was founded, clubs which were NOT in the League porgressed in the FA Challenge Cup Competition.

"The effect of the expansion of the League (*which increased from 88 to 92 clubs in 1950*) is very noticeable. The creation of the Second Division in 1892; the absorption of chief Southern League clubs to form Division 3 (South); and the formation of the Northern Section in 1920 and 1921 respectively limited the chance of the 'outsider' to capture the Cup very substantially. The recent extension of the 3rd Division to 24 clubs each is but another example of this development."

A table was beneath the above narrative showing those non-league clubs who'd made the best progress (up to the end of the 1951/52 season) which indeed showed that season to be the first where no such team got past Round 2 of the competition.

This table has been updated in a similar format to include the 2023/24 season and it reveals that there was one other season where Round 2 was the furthest a team from outside the League had progressed (that being in 2017/18). Clubs from Hampshire also feature in the table, although it's a shame there aren't a few more!

So, had the age of the 'Giant Killer' passed? Well, to take some examples - Hereford United (1972), Sutton United (1989), Lincoln City (2017) and Maidstone United (2024) proved that wasn't true.

So the message is clear:

Long Live the Age of the 'Giant Killer'!!
