THE TABLE EXPLAINED ...The table shows how many times each team has appeared in the Quarter-Final, Semi-Final and Final stages of the Hampshire Senior Cup. Example—Ryde appeared in the final five times and won it twice.

THE FINAL TWO COLUMNS ... these show the times a team has been the cup winners, there was one occasion of joint winners during the featured period.

HOW THE TEAMS ARE RANKED ... it's basically like an Olympic medals chart, ranking by cup wins, final appearances and semi-finals etc. Only teams reaching a quarter-final (Third Round in latter years) are shown.

NOTE COLUMN EXPLAINED ...

A = includes record as Southampton St. Mary's

B = includes record of the original Cowes and Winchester clubs

B = includes record when known as Eastleigh

D = Includes record of Army Medical Staff team (assumed same team)

E = Includes record as Gosport Athletic

F = subsequently known as Woolston in the final seasons during this period

G = Like Eastleigh Athletic (who do feature in the table) the Black Watch qualified for a 'Last 9' place and were beaten in an 'extra round'. This team didn't feature in the latter stages before or afterwards

A BRIEF ANALYSIS OF THE TABLE ...

Teams do not necessarily appear at the stages shown, for instance they might get a walk-over but this is included in the table ... an example of this is Banister Court F.C. who appeared nine times at the Quarter Final stage but played during the early years when there weren't so many entrants. They won only two matches in the competition on the actual field of play. Only ten clubs had won the trophy in the 27 year period and with ten outright cup wins, Southampton dominate the rankings at this point in time.

THE SUMS—27 wins (26 outright wins + 2 joint); 54 finalists; 108 semi-finalists; 216 quarter-finalists (198 in table + 6 when there were insufficient entries and 12 occasions no opponent, necessitating a bye).
